

Scrappy Oven mitts

Finished size 8 inches square approx

Requirements
This is per pair of mitts

6 pieces of wadding 8 1/2 inches square. This can be cotton or polyester. I have used cotton.
or

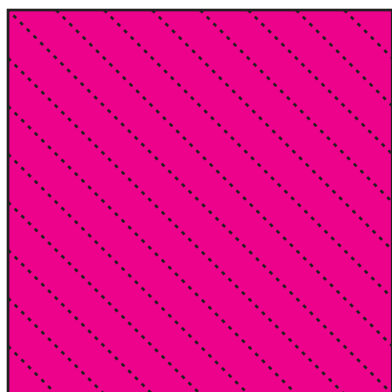
4 pieces of insulbright wadding

4 pieces of fabric 8 1/2 inches square for the lining

2 pieces of fabric 8 1/2 inches square for the back of your oven mitt

Selection of scrap strips to make up the front of the mitt, my widest one was 2 inches wide and the narrowest was 3/4 inch wide.

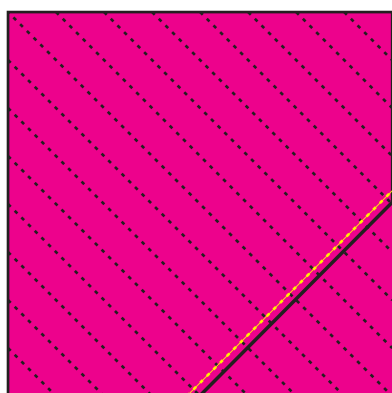
Making the back of your mitt



Take one of the wadding squares and put the lining fabric on one side and backing fabric on the other side, both right side out. Pin, tack or spray glue baste together.

Quilt the layers together.

Make 2 of this unit.

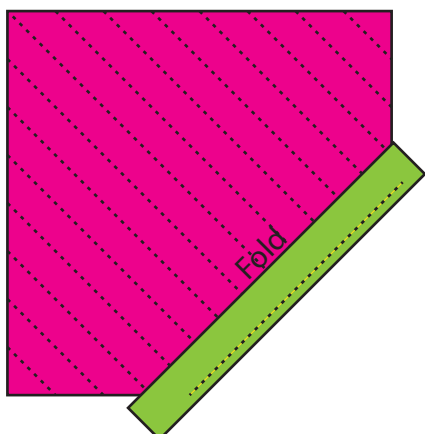


Trim both units to 8 inches square.

Measure up 4 inches from one corner and along the bottom of the same corner, draw a line on the diagonal.

Stitch across the corner just inside the drawn line.

Trim off the corner on the line.



Cut 2 pieces of fabric 2 1/2 inches wide by 8 inches long. Fold them in half down the length right side out and press the fold.

Place on the diagonal edge lining up the raw edges with diagonal line.

Stitch in place with 1/4 inch seam.

Fold over to the back and stitch in place.

Do both units the same.
