

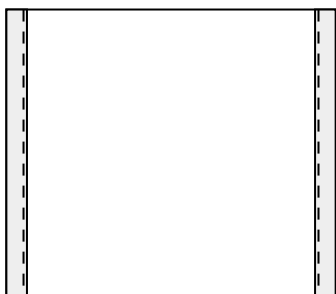
Oilcloth or pvc makeup bag

1 piece of oilcloth 14 inches wide by 16 inches long.

1 metre of bias binding

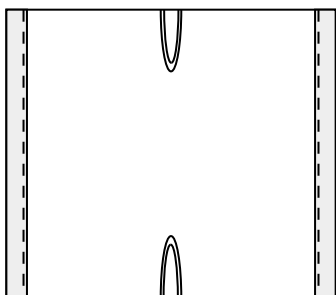
1 16 inch zip.

Take the bias binding and fold it in half down the length. Cut off 2 pieces 14 inches long.

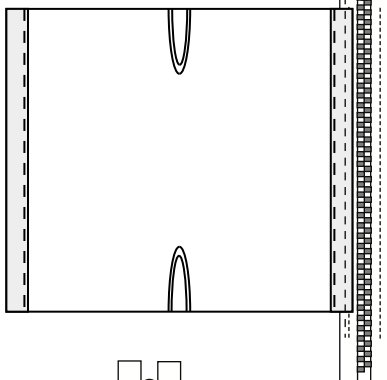


Slot them over the shorter sides and stitch down the open edges, making sure you have stitched both sides.

Take the remaining piece of bias and fold it in half and stitch down the open edge. Cut this in half to make the 2 loops on the bag

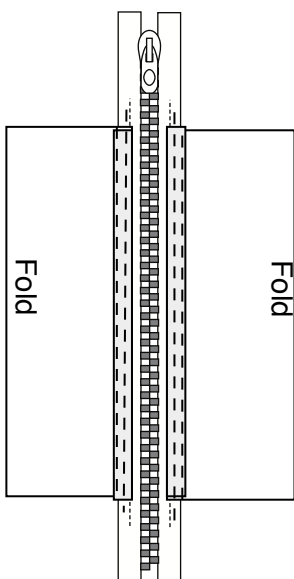


Take the loop and stitch it onto the centre of the long sides as per the diagram



Place the zipper under one edge lining the fold of the binding up with the side of the zipper teeth. Stitch in place close to the edge of the fabric binding. Use the middle of the zipper, so you don't have to stitch around the zip head.

Now line the other side of the bag panel up with the other side of the zipper and stitch as before. This is easier to stitch with the zip open.



It should now look like this.

Undo the zipper and turn the panel inside out.

Do the zipper up half way.

Line up the ends of the zip with the fabric loops. this will make sure the zip is in the middle.
