

Stackable containers Round

Requirements

6 Fat quarters of contrasting fabric
(I made 2 sets out of this)

1 Metre medium weight iron on vilene

Thread for sewing

1 1/2 Metres of polyester boning (Rigilene)

These instructions are the same for each container, pick a size and cut out the pieces and Follow the instructions.

Trace off the base templates onto template plastic

Large Container 6 inches wide by 7 inches deep
1 Piece 18 1/2 inches by 9 1/2 inches of outer fabric.
1 Piece 18 1/2 inches by 9 1/2 inches of inner fabric.
2 Bases one in inner fabric one in outer fabric cut using the largest template.

Medium Container 5 inches wide by 6 inches deep
1 Piece 15 1/2 inches by 8 1/2 inches of outer fabric.
1 Piece 15 1/2 inches by 8 1/2 inches of inner fabric.
2 Bases one in inner fabric one in outer fabric cut using the medium template.

Small Container 4 inches wide by 5 inches deep
1 Piece 12 1/2 inches by 7 1/2 inches of outer fabric.
1 Piece 12 1/2 inches by 7 1/2 inches of inner fabric.
2 Bases one in inner fabric one in outer fabric cut using the smallest template.

For each container cut the same in iron on vilene.
